Major decisions:

- The General Assembly approved the Minutes of its 5th General Assembly Meeting, held in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, 6 – 7 May 2008.
- The General Assembly endorsed the decisions adopted by the 14th Executive Board meeting held on Monday 10 Ramadan 1430H corresponding to 31 August 2009; as follows:
 1. To approve the affiliation of the following international organizations to the I.S.S.F as observers:

- The Islamic Education, Science and Culture Organization (ISESCO)
 - The Islamic Development Bank (IDB)
1. To mandate HRH the I.S.S.F President for the works of developing the Federation in order to realize its qualitative shift that suits the future plans, goals and aspirations.
 1. To create an executive bureau composed of five members as follows:
 - A chairman from the headquarter country appointed by the President to assume the position of executive vice president in order to facilitate and speed up the work of the Federation. This position is to be ratified by the General Assembly.
 - Four Board Members including the Secretary General.
 - The treasurer.
 1. To modify the Statute by adding some provision to cover the composition of the Executive Bureau; as follows:

Composition:

The Executive Bureau shall be composed of the following five members:

- A chairman from the headquarter country appointed by the President to assume the position of executive vice president in order to facilitate and speed up the work of the Federation. This position is to be ratified by the General Assembly.
- Four Board Members including the Secretary General.
- The treasurer.

Responsibilities of the Executive Bureau:

- To implement the decisions of the Executive Board and General Assembly as well as all the matters referred by them and supervise works of the federation and General Secretariat.
- To report all results to the President of the Executive Board.
- To develop investment projects and marketing programs as a means for providing financial resources for the federation.

Responsibilities of the Chairman of Executive Bureau:

- To implement all decisions of the Federation Executive Board and the General Assembly as well as matter referred from them and supervise the work of the Federation and its Secretariat.

- To supervise the preparation of programs for investment, marketing and finding new finance resources.
- To submit all the results of Office assignments to the President and members of the Executive Board to review and take appropriate decisions about them.
 - To endorse the Auditors report on I.S.S.F final accounts as on 30 Dhu al-Hijjah 1429. (End of December 2008)
 - To urge member National Olympic Committees to settle their financial obligations with the I.S.S.F and effectively contribute to advancement of the I.S.S.F programs by hosting some activities and sharing budgets.
 - To approve, in principle, the proposed activities and programs provided that the General Secretariat of the Federation may implement the appropriate activities and programs in accordance with the available financial resources and seek the participation of the largest possible number of member NOCs.
 - To exert more efforts so as to find additional financial resources, activate the Resource Development Committee and seek corporate agreements to sponsor the I.S.S.F activities for effective implementation of I.S.S.F programs.
 - To thank the Libyan Olympic Committee and endorse its request, which was submitted during the meeting, to host a taekwondo championship in 2010. The I.S.S.F General Secretariat and the Technical Committee shall coordinate with the Libyan Olympic Committee on the preparation of this event taking into consideration the participation of the largest possible number of NOCs.
 - To endorse the Executive Board's decision approving the postponement of the 2nd Islamic Solidarity Games for a period of six months as proposed by the ISGOC.
 - To take into consideration the new date (10 – 25 April 2010) as proposed by the ISG Organizing Committee.
 - To determine the final date for the Games within three months if the reasons of postponement have been removed. The Supervision & Coordination Committee shall meet with the ISGOC within two months to discuss all matters related to the postponement and propose a new date for the Games based on the developments of the situation.
 - To thank the Indonesian Olympic Committee on their report and the Government of the Republic of Indonesia for hosting the Games.
 - To give final approval to host the 3rd Islamic Solidarity Games in the Republic of Indonesia in 2013 and to begin the formation of the organizing committee as provided for in the Regulations of the Islamic Solidarity Games as well as the Supervision & Coordination Committee in order to begin working with Organizing Committee for the development of plans and programs in preparation for the Games.
