Major Decisions

- The General Assembly decided that HRH Prince Nawaf Faisal Fahd ABDULAZIZ has been elected unopposed for the remaining term.
- It was decided to present its thanks and recognition to HRH Prince Sultan Fahd ABDULAZIZ for the valuable services he rendered throughout his presidency for the I.S.S.F goals, programs and mission; particularly the 1st Islamic Solidarity Games.
- Minutes of the 6th General Assembly Meeting, held in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, 31 August – 1 September 2009 were ratified.
- The Executive Board report, decisions and recommendations were ratified.

- Due thanks were presented to HRH the I.S.S.F President, Executive Board and General Secretariat for their efforts in the realization of the I.S.S.F activities as per the report.
- The Auditors report on I.S.S.F closing accounts for the past two years (2009/2010 – 2010/2011) was approved.
- Member National Olympic Committees are urged to settle their financial obligations with the I.S.S.F and effectively contribute to advancement of the I.S.S.F programs by hosting some activities and sharing budgets.
- The proposed activities and programs were approved, in principle, provided that the General Secretariat of the Federation will take into consideration the limited available financial resources and seek the participation of the largest possible number of member NOCs.
- The Federation shall exert more efforts to find additional financial resources, activate the Resource Development Committee and seek corporate contribution to sponsor the I.S.S.F activities for effective implementation of I.S.S.F programs.
- The Assembly urged member NOCs to have more contribution to the I.S.S.F programs and activities by hosting, organizing and participating in them.
- The amended Basic Regulations of the Islamic Solidarity Games were approved and became into force on the date of approval by the General Assembly.
- The Assembly expressed its appreciation to the Government of the Republic of Indonesia for its endeavors to host the 3rd Islamic Solidarity Games and presented due thanks to the Indonesian Olympic Committee and the Governor of Riau City for the progress report they presented to the house. Member NOCs are encouraged to participation in these Games.
- Request of the General Secretariat to open the bidding process for hosting the 4th Islamic Solidarity Games in 2017 according to the I.S.S.F regulations was endorsed.
- On the occasion of holding the 3rd Islamic Solidarity Games in Indonesia in 2013, the General Assembly approved the proposal of the Executive Board to hold the 8th General Assembly meeting there if accepted by Indonesia NOC. The meeting shall be held in the days preceding the Games.
