Major Decisions:

- Minutes of the 7th General Assembly Meeting, held in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, on 4 and 5 October 2011 were ratified.
- The Executive Board report, decisions and recommendations were ratified and commended by the Assembly .
- Due thanks were presented to HRH the I.S.S.F President, Executive Board and General Secretariat for their efforts in the realization of the I.S.S.F activities as per the report.
- The Auditors report on I.S.S.F closing accounts for the past two years (2011/2012 – 2012/2013) was approved.
- Member National Olympic Committees are urged to settle their financial obligations with the I.S.S.F and effectively contribute to advancement of the I.S.S.F programs by hosting some activities and sharing budgets.
- The proposed activities and programs were approved, in principle, provided that the General Secretariat of the Federation will take into consideration the limited available financial resources and seek the participation of the largest possible number of member NOCs.
- The Federation shall exert more efforts to find additional financial resources, activate the Resource Development Committee and seek corporate contribution to sponsor the I.S.S.F activities for effective implementation of I.S.S.F programs.
- The Assembly urged member NOCs to have more contribution to the I.S.S.F programs and activities by hosting, organizing and participating in them.
- Amendments made on the Statute by the Executive Board at its 19th meeting were approved and became in force on this date.
- Basic Regulations of the Islamic Solidarity Games as submitted by the Executive Board was endorsed and became in force on that date.
- Decisions made by the Executive Board on the Progress Report of the 3rd ISG, were endorsed. Here are the main decisions:
- The city of Palembang was approved as a host for the Islamic Solidarity Games from 22 September to 01 October 2013. This information shall be circulated to member NOCs and sport organizations.
- The new sport program was approved with its 13 sports; as follows:

- The Organizing Committee shall circulate the information to member NOCs and international Federation.
- A small delegation of the Executive Board shall visit the Republic of Indonesia on an urgent basis and within ten days of the meeting to have talks with the Organizing Committee, meet with the Minister of Youth and Sport in Indonesia as well as the Governor of Palembang and inspect the readiness of the Republic to organize the Games.
- The Organizing Committee shall modify all the technical handbooks, regulations and related materials to match the new city selection. The modified materials should be circulated to member NOCs in due time.
- It was approved to hold the Chef de Mission meeting and lot drawing ceremony on 19 - 21 August 2013.
- A meeting should be held between the Supervision and Coordination Committee and the Organizing Committee to determine the cancellation of sports with insufficient participation and inspect the venues and installations.
- The Organizing Committee shall maximize its efforts to finalize all the issues related to Marketing and TV rights.
- The Organizing Committee shall intensify its contacts with member NOCs to encourage their active participation in the Games.
- The Organizing Committee shall take due action to sign a contract with an accredited laboratory for the doping control program.
- The Executive Board presented its thanks to the Government the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia for its valuable support to the I.S.S.F and the Games by donating 5 air-tickets to some NOCs.
- The Assembly decided that an Executive Board meeting would be held in Palembang during the Games.
- Azerbaijan's 4th Islamic Solidarity Games bid was approved and Baku was selected as host city for the Games in 2017.
- The Assembly expressed its appreciation to the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan for its support of the bid file of the 4th Islamic Solidarity Games.

- Member NOCs are encouraged to participation in these Games as the major sport event providing solidarity for the youth of the Ummah.
- The General Secretariat shall start action to coordinate with the Organizing Committee on the beginning of preparation stage in line with the Games regulations.
- The house welcomed Azerbaijan request to host the 9th General Assembly meeting in 2015.
