The General Guidance Program of Activities & Events

2019 -2021

This program has been prepared to assist the candidate city in preparing its program of activities & events for the title year, without being obliged to abide by it fully.

The candidate city can only use what is feasible/practicable ideas, from this program, and add other special activities of local nature such as folkloric sports and local & cultural competitions, noting the following:

- *All the Documents, Publications, Advertisements and Banners shown in the venues of activities & events. In the street and public places should carry the logo of the Program "Islamic Solidarity Sports Federation" in addition to the logo of the "Sports Capital City of the Islamic Countries".*
- *A workable timetable should be prepared by the Organizing Committee covering the preparation stage of the Program (i.e. the period preceding the start of implementing the Program) and the period of implementing the Program throughout the year starting the 1st day of launching the Program until the date of closing ceremony of the program.*

The events & activities proposed for the Program:

I- Events & Activities proposed of the opening ceremony and the one-week program organized to celebrate Capital of Sport.

- The opening ceremony and signing the MoU:
 - Introduction & films presentation
 - Speakers addresses in the opening ceremony.
 - Signing the Memorandum of Understanding.
 - Exchange of souvenirs & taking photos
 - Introductory site seeing of the city's landmarks and venues of implementing the Program.
- Exhibition of the ISSF (Entity & Implementation):
- Training course.



- Honoring ceremony of the winners in one of the ISSF competitions &/ honoring distinguished persons in other fields.
- Sport's activity.
- Conferences, Forums and Workshops.
- Sponsoring the celebration party of the winners of sports activities.

II- The Program of Closing Ceremony (which may include):

- Presentations and films
- Speakers addresses in the ceremony.
- Exchanging souvenirs as part of the honoring ceremony.
- Sport shows
- Awards ceremonies to the winners of one of the competitions of ISSF.

III- A Proposed Program for the Title Year:

a) In the field of Sport:

1- International Championships for individuals, which may include:

- Sports like Swimming, Track & Field, Gymnastic, Karate, Taekwondo, Judo, Fencing, Chess

2- Local folkloric Games for team & individuals, which may include:

- Team sport like football, basketball, volleyball, handball and athletics.
- Individual Sport, such as Islamic triathlon, gymnastics, cycling, national marathon, and marathons for senior, kids & athletes of special needs.
- Marine sports, water sports and sea-side (coastal sports).

3- Local folkloric Games/Sports that may be proposed by the city:

- Due to the fact that these Games/Sports vary from one State to State, the candidate city to choose and suggest whatever it likes from the popular & wide spread folkloric Games/Sports practiced in their city/country.
- The selected Games/Sports shall not affect or discriminate between religion, races, color or sex and should not be harmful or dangerous on practitioners or fans or characterized by a high or unacceptable degree of violence and harshness.



4- Local and/or International Training Courses:

Suggested topics:

- Sports medicine.
- Sport training, sports nutrition and organizing rest times for athletes.
- Workshop of first aid for sport injuries and Cardio-Pulmonary Recovery.
- Sport management & organization.
- Sport investment & marketing.

5- Local &/or International Conferences, Seminars and Forums.

Suggested topics:

- Privatization of clubs & training centers.
- Transformation of the Governmental Institutions & development of Governmental framework involved in sport.
- Investment of sport facilities & public sport centers.
- Sports professionalism.
- Sport culture & media.
- Investment of sport rights and sponsorship.
- Investments on entertainments & tourism programs.
- Efforts exerted by States to sponsor and develop community sport programs.
- The status of women's sport in the Islamic states and means of their development.
- The importance of schools' sport and street sport in producing & locating the sport talents.
- Programs & Institutions of preparing superstar athletes.
- Ways of confronting of intolerance & discrimination in sport.
- Developing sports in the Member states of the organization of Islamic Cooperation (2017-2025).



b) In the field of Youth:

1- Competitions for Youth (amateur & professional):

Suggested areas:

- Hobbies & scientific inventions.
- The art of photography, painting & Islamic calligraphy.
- Memorizing & recitation of the Holy Quran.
- Designing computer software and mobile applications.
- Initiatives of youth to serve community.
- Youth, sport, cultural & scientific competitions.
- Writing & authorizing skills.
- Sport commentary.

2- Conferences, Seminars & Forums:

Suggested topics:

- The role of youth in culture exchange & people's experience.
- The role and contribution of youth in the convergence of civilizations, the dialogue between religions and dissemination of the tolerance between human beings.
- The problem of unemployment, drug abuse and how to fill the leisure time of the youth.
- The successful business initiatives based on the intelligent idea and individual efforts.
- The collective initiatives of youth to create job opportunities or volunteer work.
- The participation of youth in planning & decision making and carrying out these decisions in public and private sectors.
- The impact of social platforms/networking on the life of youth and exploiting them to create jobs.
- The strategy of the Islamic Conference of Youth & Sport Ministers of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation in the field of youth in Muslim Countries.



3- Training Courses, Programs & Workshops:

Suggested topics:

- Electronic marketing & mobile applications.
- Science of Project Management.
- Volunteering & community service.
- Vocational courses such as Computer & mobile repairing, photography, communication networks & networks of the surveillance cameras & computers, fashion design.....etc.
- Designing, management and carrying out parties/celebrations and activities.
- Methods of communication and developing the personality.

c) In the Cultural, Scientific and Economical fields:

1- Conferences, seminars and Forums:

Suggested topics:

- Contemporary cultural issues.
- The book industry and consolidating the habit of reading.
- Locating, taking care of and supporting the talents.
- The impact of information technology on economy and business.
- The future of informatic on the development and progress of the nations.

2- Competitions in both the cultural and Scientific fields:

Suggested areas:

- Hobbies & scientific inventions.
- Writing and authorizing hobbies.
- Creative arts such as painting, Arabic calligraphy, sculpture ... etc.
- Hobbies of acting, performance on stage and movies.
- Hobbies of presentation on Radio & TV.
- Hobbies of writing and reading poetry.



d) Entertainment & Tourism:

- designing and organization of entertainment and tourism programs that will accompany the General Program of the activities and events of the ISSF Program of Sports Capital of the Islamic Countries. The entertainment and tourism programs shall be organized in accordance with the city's/country's possession of tourist attractions archeological sites and as the entertainment/recreational capabilities of the city/country.

e) Festivals & Exhibitions:

- Planning for and implementing a number of festivals & exhibitions to accompany the General Program of the activities and events of the ISSF Program of Sports Capital of the Islamic Countries (that contained activities in all areas of sport, education, science, entertainment, tourism.....etc.

f) Inspecting on and qualifying the facilities & installations:

- Developing a schedule of inspection visit on the related sites to study the real condition of all facilities, installations and fixtures and inventory thereof located in the city or in the surrounding area involved in hosting the events and activities of the Program throughout the year of title.
- Developing an integrated & detailed plan on the local, regional and central levels to rehabilitate & expand the existed facilities and installations and/or developing others, where necessary, and to modernize and qualify the related fixtures to be ready for use as from the start of the events and activities of the ISSF Program of Sports Capital of the Islamic Countries.
